6. Home Care and Telemedicine Services: Keeping up with the recent times to provide safe care even away from the hospital campus, the hospital has initiated home services and telemedicine. The home services provide pharmacy, laboratory, nursing, physiotherapy and geriatric services at home. The hospital has also initiated COVID home care for asymptomatic isolation patients. The telemedicine team gives access to all our clinicians to our patients seated at various locations across Karnataka.
