Details: hosted by representatives of 2019 Batch. Roughly 50 students were in attendance along with Dr Sheetal Savur.

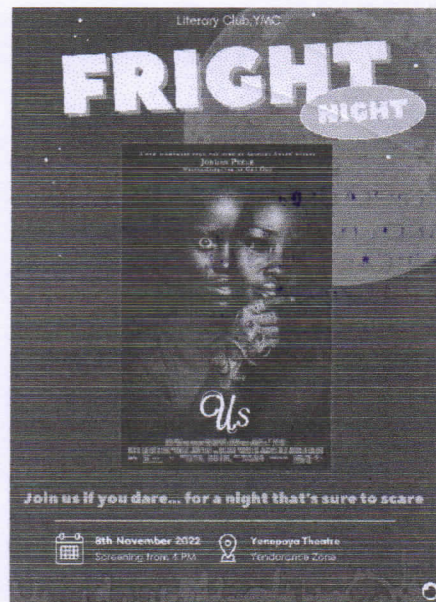
Agenda: Screening the movie, 'Us' dir. Jordan Peele as a prequel to the movie discussion to be held on 10/11/2022, Thursday.
